I Places where the right to apply cannot be exercised:

It is not possible to use the right of application in the following cases:

- Processing of personal data for purposes such as research, planning and statistics by anonymizing them with official statistics.
- Processing personal data for art, history, literature or scientific purposes or within the scope of freedom of expression, provided that it does not violate national defense, national security, public security, public order, economic security, privacy of private life or personal rights or constitute a crime.
- Processing of personal data within the scope of preventive, protective and intelligence activities carried out by public institutions and organizations authorized by law to ensure national defence, national security, public security, public order or economic security.
- Processing of personal data by judicial authorities or execution authorities in relation to investigation, prosecution, trial or execution proceedings.

The right to apply, except for the right to request compensation for damage, in the following cases cannot be used:

- Processing personal data is necessary for the prevention of crime or criminal investigation.
- Processing of personal data made public by the person concerned.
- Personal data processing is necessary for the execution of auditing or regulatory duties and disciplinary investigation or prosecution by public institutions and organizations and professional organizations that are public institutions, based on the authority granted by the law.
- Personal data processing is necessary to protect the economic and financial interests of the State regarding budget, tax and financial matters.

IV- Application Fee

- In principle, it is essential that the Relevant Person's request is finalized free of charge. No fee will be charged for written responses of up to 10 pages to the Relevant Person's application.
- However, if the work and operations to be carried out to finalize the request require a cost, a processing fee of 1 Turkish lira may be charged for each page over 10 pages in written responses.
- For answers that are not written and are given on recording media such as CD
 or flash memory, the fee that can be requested is determined not to exceed
 the cost of the recording medium used.
- If it is understood that the application is due to Ipsos Turkey's error, the fee collected from the Relevant Person within the scope of this article will be refunded.

V- Responding to your applications

Your applications will be responded to with justification, either in writing to your notification address or by e-mail sent to your e-mail address.

Depending on the nature of your requests, your requests will be finalized as soon as possible and within 30 (thirty) days from the date your application reaches us.

VI- About the application form

The application form below has been prepared entirely to help you complete your applications accurately and completely in accordance with the Personal Data Protection Law No. 6698 (KVKK) and to provide your convenience.

Whether or not this form is used, your applications must include all the information and documents listed below, and if there is any deficiency, it will not be possible for your applications to be evaluated. In these cases, you will be informed within 30 (thirty) business days at the latest from the date your application is received.

Your applications are within the scope of Article 5/2 of the Personal Data Protection Law; It will be kept in our records for at least 2 years, together with all documents and information, to the extent necessary for the fulfillment of our legal obligations and the establishment, use or protection of our rights.
